## Parents Code of Ethics

WSJFT – West Seattle Junior Football

We are very excited and proud to have you join our Football Family. We have no doubt you will bring an encouraging voice and display the best sportsmanship ever. We also know that any competitive sport brings out a competitive spirit in all of us. It is for that reason some of us might need a small reminder that we are here to have FUN, to teach our children about TEAMWORK, and to show COMMUNITY SUPPORT. With that said, there are some rules that need to be stated and are to be followed at all times.

1. Drugs are illegal and are not allowed at any event WSJFT and/or its affiliates are hosting. We will prosecute to the fullest extent of the Law if this rule is violated in any way.
2. Alcohol is not permitted at or around practice and or game fields.
3. Tobacco products are not permitted within 100 yards of practice and or game fields.
4. Great sportsmanship is demanded and should be displayed at all times.
5. All questions and concerns will be handled the 1<sup>st</sup> practice after a weekend game. Game Day is off limits to any negativity that might cause an ill effect to the integrity of the Franchise, the good nature of the event, and overall outlook on our Community.
6. Our language (no profanity) on Tuesday should be the same language used on Sunday!!!
7. Having FUN is MANDATORY.
8. Parents are responsible for any and all guests that accompany them and/or their children to a WSJFT event. It is up to you to explain these rules to family and friends, they are representing you. Any violation by them will be a violation by you.
9. Weapons are not permitted on or around any field hosted by WSJFT and/or its affiliates.
10. Please respect all volunteers. People put great efforts into providing you an enjoyable experience.

I have the utmost confidence that these Rules and Ethic Codes are just a mere formality that we have to go through, as do all Insured Franchises.
